

Dear Candidate:

Pursuant to Section 10-1200 of the Philadelphia Code of Ordinances, please be advised that no temporary sign, banner, poster, sticker, etc., including commercial advertising and campaign posters, may be placed on any utility pole, streetlight, traffic or parking device, historical marker, City owned tree, or tree in the right-of-way.

You must remove all such signs immediately. Any sign that is not removed will be confiscated by the City and in accordance with the Philadelphia Code you will be billed for the cost incurred for the removal plus a \$75 penalty.
